FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** and the **Department of Corrections** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** state this legislation will require:

- Procedures to be revised by a Management Analyst Specialist I requiring 40 hours at a cost of \$840 in FY `15.
- The Missouri Titling Manual to be revised requiring 40 hours of overtime at a cost of \$840 in FY `15.
- The Department's web site will need to be updated. This will require 10 hours for an Administrative Analyst III, at a cost of \$230 in FY `15.

In summary, DOR assumes a cost of \$1,910 (\$840 + \$840 + \$230) in FY 2015 to provide for the implementation of the changes in this proposal.

Oversight assumes DOR is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. Oversight assumes DOR could absorb the costs related to this proposal. If multiple bills pass which require additional staffing and duties at substantial costs, DOR could request funding through the appropriation process.
