ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Revenue** and the **State Tax Commission** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** believe the department can handle the provisions of this proposal under existing appropriations. However, should the number of companies seeking new licenses be greater than anticipated, the department may have to request additional personal services appropriations through the budget process.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.
