#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials at the **Department of Economic Development's Division of Business and Community Services**, the **Office of State Treasurer** and the **Department of Revenue** each assume this proposal would have no fiscal impact to their respective organizations.

In response to a previous version, officials at the **State Tax Commission** assumed no fiscal impact from this proposal.

In response to a previous version, officials at St. Louis County, the City of Jefferson, the Platte County Board of Election Commission, the City of Kansas City, the City of Columbia, the City of O'Fallon and Cole County each assumed no fiscal impact to their respective organizations from this proposal.

Officials at Boone County, St. Charles County and Jefferson County did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

#### §99.845 Redevelopment Projects

Officials at the **Department of Economic Development** and the **Department of Revenue** each assume there is no fiscal impact to their respective organizations from this proposal.

counties, Cole County would receive a small positive fiscal impact. For 2013, Cole County would have saved \$841.14 due to not paying §67.700 tax revenues. In the future, positive impact would likely improve because another TIF project is getting off the ground.

Oversight assumes that this proposal would have no fiscal impact.

## **FISCAL DESCRIPTION**

This bill exempts taxes imposed on sales for capital improvements in certain counties enacted after August 28, 2013, for the purpose of funding emergency communication systems from the provisions regarding tax increment financing local sales taxes.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
