FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services, Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** and the **Division of Fire Safety, Department of Transportation,** and the **Department of Revenue** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Oversight assumes the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact.

Senate Amendment 1 - recall provisions of emergency services board members:

Oversight assumes the occurrence of a recall of an emergency services board member would occur infrequently. Oversight also assumes that if the recall process would progress to the point of being submitting to the voters of the district, that the election would occur on an already scheduled election date; therefore, additional costs would be nominal. With these assumptions, Oversight will assume this amendment will not create a fiscal impact to local election authorities.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
