Bill Summary: This proposal requires all members of a public water supply district board of directors to be voters who have resided in the district for one year prior to election and allows certain sewer districts to seek voter approval of a fee for a lateral sewer service line repair program.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

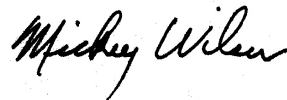
FISCAL DESCRIPTION
