FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Economic Development - Division of Business and Community Services** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at St. Louis County, the City of Columbia, the City of Kansas City and the City of Jefferson each assume no fiscal impact to their respective organizations from this proposal.

Officials at **Cole County** assume no impact from this proposal. It is unclear whether this addition applies to all counties or just that charter county with more than 600,000 and less than 700,000. If it applies to all counties, Cole County would receive a small positive fiscal impact. For 2013, Cole County would have saved \$841.14 due to not paying §67.700 tax revenues. In the future, positive impact would likely improve because another TIF project is getting off the ground.

Oversight assumes that this proposal would have no fiscal impact.

Officials at the Department of Revenue and the State Tax Commission did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.
