FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of Administration (OA) - Information Technology Services Division (ITSD)/DSS** states this proposal would require multiple changes to the Family and Children's Electronic System (FACES) in the Child Abuse and Neglect (CA/N) Assignment and Managed Reporting processes.

All three sections of the proposal affect the same programs.

Total Cost: 184 hours X \$63.04/hr = \$ 11,599 (rounded)

Match rate for FACES is 50% GR and 50% Federal.

Cost from General Revenue Funds = \$5,800 (rounded)

Cost from Federal Funds = \$5,800 (rounded)

Oversight assumes the system changes required by this proposal can be accomplished with existing resources.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services (DSS) - Children's Division (CD)** state this proposal extends the amount of the time the CD has to complete child abuse and neglect investigations and the amount of time the CD has to provide the alleged perpetrator with written notification of the CD's determination.

In 210.145.15, this proposal changes the deadline for completing child abuse neglect investigations from 30 days to 45 days. This section also extends the amount of time the CD has to update the information system from 30 days to 45 days when the investigation cannot be completed within the 45 days.

<u>ASSUMPTION</u> (continued)

This section will provide some additional time for the CD to complete investigations and collect the necessary evidence to support investigative conclusions. The CD does not anticipate a fiscal impact as a result of this section.

In 210.183.1, this proposal increases the amount of time the CD has to make every reasonable attempt to the complete the investigation from 30 days to 45 days, except if a child involved in the pending investigation dies, the investigation shall remain open until the division's investigation surrounding the death is completed. In this section, this proposal also extends the amount of time the CD has to provide written notification to the alleged perpetrator of its determination from 90 days to 100 days.

This section will provide some additional time for the CD to notify the alleged perpetrator of the CD's determination. The CD does not anticipate a fiscal impact as result of this section.
