#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Insurance**, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, the **Department of Mental Health**, and the **Department of Social Services** (**DOS**) each assume the current proposal will not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from DOS also stated that currently law, Section 337.603(2), RSMo, provides a licensing exemption for social workers employed by an agency or department of the state of Missouri while discharging the person's duties in that capacity.
