FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Office of the Secretary of State, the Department of Revenue, the Department of Natural Resources, the State Tax Commission, the Administrative Hearing Commission, the Department of Economic Development - Public Service Commission and the Department of Economic Development - Office of the Public Counsel each assume the current proposal will not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

In response to a similar proposal from last session, HB 198, officials from the **Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District (MSD)** assumed no fiscal impact to their district since the Public Service Commission does not govern their rates because MSD is a non-profit political subdivision and does not operate for gain.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business
