#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their agency or on school districts.

Officials from the **Carthage School District (CSD)** state that, as of this date they are approaching the maximum allowable transfer from the Incidental Fund (Fund 1) to the Capital Projects fund (Fund 4) for the construction of a new Early Childhood Center in the district. CSD needs more money in Fund 4 for safety and security projects that have been identified through a year-long community engagement process.

If this legislation were passed, it would enable CSD to spend additional funds from their district's carryover balances for Capital Projects in the area of safety and security.

Currently CSD is projecting a carryover balance in Fund 1 of 34.40% (\$13.4 million) after they have made the allowable transfers from Fund 1 to Fund 4.

If allowed to do so, CSD will transfer funds from Fund 1 to Fund 4, not to exceed the 20% fund balance limit established in this bill. A 20% balance represents a surplus balance of \$7.8 million.

**Oversight** assumes this would only be a transfer from one fund to another within the Carthage School District accounts and would not have a direct fiscal impact.
