FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Office of Child Advocate (OCA)** state section 37.710.2(5), RSMo would increase the responsibility of and the length of time the OCA is involved in a case and would likely increase the number of cases. OCA would need one new investigator at \$48,000 annually, plus benefits and related equipment and expense of \$2,729. This position would review cases and coordinate with the Attorney General's Office to file pleadings necessary to intervene on behalf of the child. This individual would require experience working with the Children's Division, Juvenile Officers and the courts.

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General** assume any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources. The AGO may seek additional appropriations if there is a significant increase in referrals.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services (DSS)** indicate that this proposal will have no fiscal impact on the **Children's Division**, the **Division of Legal Services**, or the **Division of Youth Services**.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator**, the **Department of Mental Health**, and the **Department of Health and Senior Services** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.
