FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri House of Representatives**, the **Office of Administration - Budget and Planning** and the **Office of the State Treasurer** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources** defer to the Office of the State Treasurer and the Office of Administration - Budget and Planning for fiscal impact to their organization.

Officials from the **Missouri Senate** state the proposal will have no fiscal impact or minimal cost which can be absorbed by present appropriations.

According to the Office of Administration, the net general revenue collection for fiscal years 2012 and 2013 was \$7.34 billion and \$8.08 billion respectively (total of \$15.42 billion for the two year period). **Oversight** will range the fiscal impact from \$0 (the state does not receive \$16.834 billion in net general revenue collection for the FY '14 - FY '15 period) to the \$215,000,000 transfer to the Surplus Revenue Fund.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill requires up to \$215 million of General Revenue Funds to be deposited into the newly created Surplus Revenue Fund if during the two-year period beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2015, state general revenue collections net of refunds exceed \$16,834,000,000. Moneys in the fund shall be subject to appropriation by the General Assembly.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
