Bill Summary: This proposal modifies provisions relating to evidence of financial responsibility for certified pesticide applicators.

Local Fiscal Highlights


- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

§ 281.065 - Commercial Pesticide Applicators:

Officials from the **Department of Agriculture**, the **Department of Natural Resources**, and the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Direct fiscal impact to small business pesticide applicators could be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
