Bill Summary: This proposal exempts, in bankruptcy proceedings, up to fifteen thousand

dollars of life insurance proceeds for the burial of a spouse, parent or

child.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Insurance**, **Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** and the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assume that any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
