**Bill Summary:** This proposal requires persons who submit petitions for political subdivision audits to reside or own property in the subdivision and allows for signatures to be rescinded.

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.


Local Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Office of the State Auditor** and the **City of Kansas City** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
