Bill Summary: This proposal requires persons who submit petitions for political subdivision audits to reside or own property in the subdivision and allows for signatures to be rescinded.

State Fiscal Highlights

• No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

• No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Office of the State Auditor**, the **Department of Revenue**, the **Joint Committee on Administrative Rules**, the **Office of Administration - Budget and Planning**, the **State Tax Commission** and the **Office of the Secretary of State** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

In response to a previous version, officials from the **City of Kansas City** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
