#### Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Department of Social Services, the Office of Administration - Division of Personnel, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Attorney General's Office, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Office of the Secretary of State, the Department of Transportation, the Department of Public Safety - State Emergency Management Agency and Missouri National Guard, the City of Independence, the City of Kansas City, the City of Jefferson, Platte County and St. Louis County each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety** - **Missouri Highway Patrol**, the **Department of Mental Health** and the **Department of Corrections** defer to the Office of Administration for possible fiscal impact toe their respective organizations.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
