Bill Summary: This proposal prohibits an employer from requiring a person to become a

member of a labor organization as a condition or continuation or

employment.

State Fiscal Highlights

• No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Division of Personnel** and the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Veterans Commission** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assume any potential cost arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.

In response to a previous verison, officials from the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Department of Social Services, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Office of the Secretary of State, the Department of Transportation, the Department of Public Safety - State Emergency Management Agency and Missouri National Guard, the City of Independence, the City of Kansas City, the City of Jefferson, Platte County and St. Louis County each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Mental Health** defer to the Office of Administration to estimate the fiscal impact of the proposed legislation on their organization.

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** and the **Department of Corrections** deferred to the Office of Administration for possible fiscal impact toe their respective organizations.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
