Bill Summary: This proposal prohibits an employer from requiring a person to become a

member of a labor organization as a condition or continuation or

employment.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the Office of Administration - Division of Personnel, the Department of Transportation, the Department of Social Services, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules and the Department of Public Safety - Missouri National Guard each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assume any potential cost arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.

In response to a previous verison, officials from the **Department of Labor and Industrial**Relations, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Office of the Secretary of State, the Department of Public Safety - State Emergency Management Agency the City of Independence, the City of Kansas City, the City of Jefferson, Platte County and St. Louis County each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Mental Health**, **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol**, the **Department of Corrections** defer to the Office of Administration to estimate the fiscal impact of the proposed legislation on their organization.
