FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of Administration** state that this proposal would require ITSD to make changes to the Missouri Accountability Portal to provide for this ability. The OA - ITSD assume the project would require 133.92 hours of IT consultant work at a rate of \$75 per hour in FY16. Future years would require a reduced cost for maintenance of the system. In summary, OA-ITSD assumes a cost of \$10,044 in FY 2016, \$2,059 in FY 2017, and \$2,110 in FY 2018.

Officials from the Missouri Lottery Commission, the Joint Committee on Legislative Research, the Department of Public Safety, the MoDOT and Patrol Employees Retirement System, the Office of the Governor, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Department of Social Services, the Missouri Gaming Commission, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Department of Revenue, the Office of the State Auditor, the Office of Prosecution Services, the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration and the Office of Administration - Divisions of Purchasing and Accounting assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources**, the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol**, and the **Department of Economic Development** defer to Office of Administration for fiscal impact.

Officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** assume this proposal, may have some fiscal impact, but there is no way to quantify the amount currently. Any significant changes will be reflected in future budget requests.

Officials from the **Missouri Lieutenant Governor** assume this proposal would have little or no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the **Joint Committee on Administrative Rules** state that the proposal is not anticipated to cause a fiscal impact to their agency beyond its current appropriation.

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Joint Committee on Public Retirement** stated that this legislation would not create a substantial proposed change in future plan benefits as defined in Section 105.660(10).

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assume that any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.
