Bill Summary: This proposal prohibits restrictive physician employment contracts.

Local Fiscal Highlights


- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** and the **Office of State Courts Administrator** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

The proposal may impact small businesses medical practices that use restrictive agreements to limit the geographic area to which departing physicians can relocate.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
