
- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

§ 442.013 - Solar Energy Systems:

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources, Department of Economic Development, the Office of State Courts Administrator, the City of Kansas City, City of Jefferson, and the City of Columbia** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Direct positive fiscal impact to small businesses that design and install solar energy systems would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
