Bill Summary: This proposal provides that boards and commissions under the Division of Professional Registration may issue certain opinions for educational purposes.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

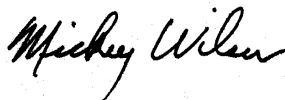
Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** believe the provisions of this bill can be handled within current appropriations. However, should the extent of the work be more than anticipated, some boards may require an additional FTE and expenses, which would be requested through the appropriation process.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
