Bill Summary: This proposal changes the laws regarding police retirement.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Joint Committee on Public Employee Retirement** state that this legislation would not create a substantial proposed change in future plan benefits as defined in Section 105.660(10).

Officials from the **Kansas City Police Retirement System** and the **St. Louis Police Retirement System** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
