Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the Missouri State Employees Retirement System, the Missouri Local Government Employees Retirement System, the Joint Committee on Public Employee Retirement, the County Employees Retirement Fund, the Prosecuting and Circuit Attorneys' Retirement System, the Police Retirement System of St. Louis, the Kansas City Public School Retirement System, the Kansas City Police Employees' Retirement System and the Sheriffs' Retirement System each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
