Subject: Transportation; Motor Vehicles; Revision Bills

Bill Summary: This proposal repeals exceptions to the duty of scrap metal operators to obtain certificates of title for certain inoperable vehicles.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.


In response to a similar proposal (SB 597) from 2014, officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** and the **Department of Transportation** each assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a similar proposal (SB 597) from 2014, officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** state this legislation will require procedures to be revised by a Management Analyst Specialist I requiring 40 hours of overtime at a cost of \$840 in FY 15.

Oversight assumes DOR is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. Oversight assumes DOR could absorb the costs related to this proposal.

Fiscal Analysis (continued)

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
