Bill Summary: This proposal creates additional requirements for tow truck businesses and penalties for tow trucks responding to accidents in violation of the provisions of the act.

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.


Local Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol**, the **Office of the State Courts Administrator**, the **Department of Transportation**, the **Department of Revenue**, the **City of Kansas City**, **St Louis County**, the **Boone County Sheriff's Department**, the **Springfield Police Department**, the **University of Central Missouri**, the **Missouri State University**, the **University of Missouri Western**, the **Metropolitan Community College** and the **State Technical College of Missouri** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Small towing businesses could be impacted by this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
