- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.


Fiscal Analysis

§ 275.352 - Beef Commodity Merchandising Fees:

Officials from the **Department of Agriculture** assume this proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Division of Budget and Planning** assume this proposal will have no direct fiscal impact on total state revenue.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
