Local Fiscal Highlights


- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

In response to a previous version, officials at the **Office of the Attorney General** assumed that any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.

In response to a previous version, officials at the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration**, the **Joint Committee on Administrative Rules** and the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** each assumed no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

There could be a direct fiscal impact to small business medical providers as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
