Bill Summary: This proposal adds a provision relating to annexation of property approved by a majority of the property owners.

State Fiscal Highlights

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis


Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials at the **City of Kansas City** and the **Platte County Board of Election Commission** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

In response to similar legislation filed in 2014, HB 2112, officials at the **St. Louis Board of Election Commission**, the **Kansas City Board of Election Commission**, the **Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District**, the **City of Columbia** and the **City of Jefferson** each assumed no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

FISCAL ANALYSIS (continued)

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
