FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials at the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education**, Malta Bend Schools each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **Kansas City Public Schools** assume an impact of less than \$10,000.

Officials at the Everton R-III School District assume a cost of \$4,000.

Oversight assumes this proposal requires that current health classes teach about sexual predators, online predators and the consequences of inappropriate texting. Oversight assumes school districts should be able to include this information in their current health courses and would not have any additional fiscal impact.
