FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

In response to a similar proposal from this year, HB 494, officials from the **Joint Committee on Public Retirement** stated that the legislation would not create a substantial proposed change in future plan benefits as defined in Section 105.660(10).

In response to a similar proposal from this year, HB 494, officials from the **Missouri Local Government Employees Retirement System (LAGERS)** assumed the proposal would not have a fiscal impact on their organization. It is anticipated to have no cost or a potential costs savings to local governments by effectively transitioning legacy plan administration into the LAGERS system thereby taking advantage of the efficiencies and scale of LAGERS. The decision to elect LAGERS administration is voluntary to local governments.
