Bill Summary: This proposal allows for direct primary health care services to be provided

through a medical retainer agreement between the physician and patient.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the Office of Administration, the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, the Department of Mental Health, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Department of Social Services, the Department of Transportation, the Department of Health and Senior Services, and the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** defer to Department of Transportation for fiscal impact.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
