Bill Summary: This proposal exempts users of enclosed three wheel vehicles that contain

manufacturer-installed seat belts with shoulder restraints from the

requirement to wear helmets.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol, the Department of Corrections, the Department of Transportation, the Department of Revenue, the Office of the State Public Defender, the Office of Prosecution Services and the Office of the State Courts Administrator each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
