Subject: Licenses - Professional; Boards, Commissions, Committees, Councils; Physicians

Bill Summary: This proposal provides that the state shall not require maintenance of licensure or any form of specialty medical board certification to practice medicine.

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.


Local Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration**, the **Department of Mental Health**, the **Department of Social Services** and the **Department of Health and Senior Services** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
