Subject: Licenses - Professional; Boards, Commissions, Committees, Councils; Physicians

Bill Summary: This proposal provides that the state shall not require maintenance of licensure or any form of specialty medical board certification to practice medicine.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Insurance**, **Financial Institutions and Professional Registration**, the **Department of Mental Health**, the **Department of Social Services** and the **Department of Health and Senior Services** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.
