Fiscal Analysis

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials at the **Office of the State Auditor** and the **Office of Administration** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

Officials at the City of Kansas City and the Platte County Board of Election Commission each assume no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

Oversight assumes this proposal removes the sunset from provisions related to amending county budgets and will have no fiscal impact.
