Officials at the Office of the Secretary of State, the Office of the State Auditor and the Office of Administration each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

In response to a previous version, officials at the **City of Kansas City** and the **Platte County Board of Election Commission** each assumed no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

Officials at the **Callaway County Commission** responded to our request, but did not provide Oversight with a response on fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes this proposal extends the expiration date on a provision that allows counties to decrease their annual budgets and will have no fiscal impact.
