# **ASSUMPTION**

**Oversight** was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

**Oversight** notes HCS HB 1846 (2014) contains language for the section of the current proposal that appears to be identical, although it also has other provisions in it that are not contained in the current proposal. However, since the fiscal note for HCS HB 1846 indicated there would be no fiscal impact, Oversight assumes the impact for the current proposal will also be no impact.
