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FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Higher Education** assume this proposal expands the degree-granting authority of Harris-Stowe State University. Any new program will need to be reviewed and approved by the Coordinating Board of Higher Education. No fiscal impact is expected.

Officials at the **Missouri State University** responded to the proposal but could not estimate a direct fiscal impact.

Officials at the **Harris-Stowe State University** did not respond to Oversight's request for fiscal impact.

Officials at the Metropolitan Community College, State Technical College of Missouri, St. Louis Community College, University of Central Missouri and the University of Missouri each assume there is no fiscal impact to their respective college or university from this proposal.

Oversight assumes that the language changing the composition of the Northwest Missouri State University board of regents would not have a direct fiscal impact on the State.
