#### **ASSUMPTION**

§ 260.283 - Paper, Plastic, and Reusable Bags:

In response to the previous version of this proposal, the Department of Economic Development, Department of Natural Resources, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Department of Conservation, Office of the Attorney General, Office of Administration - Division of Personnel, Office of Administration - Division of Accounting, Southwest Missouri Solid Waste Management - District N, University of Missouri, State Technical College of Missouri, Kansas City Metro Community College, State Fair Community College, University of Central Missouri, St. Louis County, City of Kansas City, City of Columbia, and the City of Jefferson each assumed this provision would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

**Oversight** assumes there is no direct fiscal impact from this provision on state or local government funds.

§ 285.055 - Political subdivision regulation of the minimum wage:

#### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

## § 260.283 - Paper, Plastic, and Reusable Bags:

This provision would allow small business merchants, vendors, and peddlers to continue offering paper or plastic bags to their customers, and consumers could <u>not</u> be prevented from using reusable bags in small businesses by a political subdivision.

#### § 285.055 - Political subdivision regulation of the minimum wage:

This provision prohibits a political subdivision from mandating a minimum wage on small businesses higher than the requirements of federal, state laws, rules, or regulations.

#### FISCAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
