Subject: Public Safety Department; Railroad, Licenses - Driver's

Bill Summary: This proposal prohibits any law enforcement officer from requiring a member of the crew of a locomotive or train to display a driver's license in connection with the operation of a locomotive or train.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights


- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Revenue** and the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a similar proposal (HB 1305) from 2014, officials from the **Department of Transportation** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
