Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of local government responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials at the **State Tax Commission** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

**Oversight** assumes this proposal modifies the composition of tax increment financing commissions in Boone County and would have no fiscal impact.
