Fiscal Analysis

In response to similar legislation this year, HB 807, officials at the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** assume this section of the proposed legislation moves the 12th Division of the 16th Judicial Circuit Court from the city of Kansas City to the city of Independence. There may be some impact but there is no way to quantify that currently. Any significant changes will be reflected in future budget requests.

Officials at the City of Kansas City assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
