Bill Summary: This proposal allows the Governor to convey the state's interest in specified property owned by the state in St. Louis County to the county.

State Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the County of St. Louis, the Office of Administration, and the Office of the Governor each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the Attorney General's Office assume that any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
