**Bill Summary:** This proposal allows the Governor to convey the state's interest in specified property owned by the state in St. Louis County to the county.

Local Fiscal Highlights


- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Office of the Governor**, the **Office of Administration** and the **County of St. Louis** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assume that any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
