Subject: Pharmacy; Administrative Rules; Administrative Law; Licenses - Professional; Drugs and Controlled Substances

Bill Summary: This proposal provides that all licensees regulated by the Board of Pharmacy shall report disciplinary actions taken by another licensing jurisdiction against such person or entity's license.

Local Fiscal Highlights


- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.
