**Bill Summary:** This proposal provides that all licensees regulated by the Board of Pharmacy shall report disciplinary actions taken by another licensing jurisdiction against such person or entity's license.

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.


Local Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration**, the **Department of Mental Health**, the **Department of Social Services**, the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Missouri Department of Conservation**, and the **Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
