Section 336.115

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration (DIFP)** assume the proposed language would potentially increase investigations and discipline cases for the optometry board. The department believes that this can be accomplished under existing appropriation; however, if higher than expected increases in investigations and disciplines result from the implementation of this bill, additional FTE and/or expenses would be requested through the appropriation process.

No fiscal impact to DIFP is anticipated from any other sections of this proposal.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.
