FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **City of Kansas City** state if the proposed legislation is passed, there may be additional cost to the City because it creates a new cause of action for discrimination. The amount per fiscal year is unknown.

Officials from the **Office of Administration**, the **Missouri Department of Conservation**, the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations** and the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Transportation** did not respond to our request for fiscal impact.

For fiscal note purposes, **Oversight** will show an unknown cost to local political subdivisions.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

Under current law, no employer or agent shall discharge or in any way discriminate against any employee for exercising any of his or her rights under workers' compensation statutes. This act changes that so that no employer or agent shall discharge or discriminate against any employee for exercising any of his or her rights under this chapter when the exercising of such rights is the exclusive cause of the discharge.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
